

SELF-ADMINISTRATION OF ASTHMA INHALER OR EPIPEN

If a child must carry an inhaler or epipen with him or her due to the severity of their medical condition, a statement signed by their health care provider or the signed statement below must accompany the medication consent form. The statement must include verification that the child is qualified and able to self-administer the medication. The child must notify the school nurse immediately following each use of the asthma inhaler or epipen.

The school reserves the right to confiscate the inhaler or epipen if the school policy is abused or ignored.
